Without a doubt, May is happy to be Jehovah's Witnesses. "Jehovah is God's name and I'm just happy to bear that name," she said.




Wicca was introduced to Margie Valentine '17 by one of her older friends. She enjoys the freedom of worship, where there is not a set god for practicioners.


Greek and Roman gods are where some Wiccan find their place. Valentine Muslim prays to Goddes Diana, the Roman goddess of the hunt.
