In May, 125 students participated in an online questionnaire that looked at their cell phone use. The following statistics were tabulated from the survey.

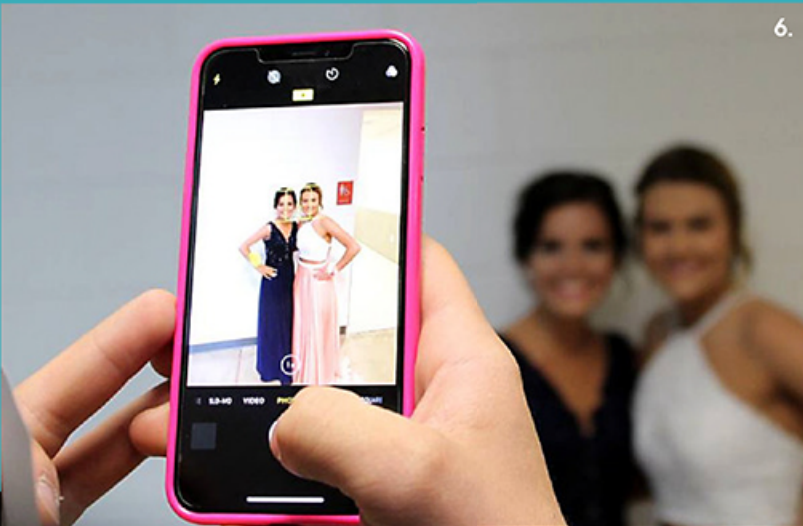
