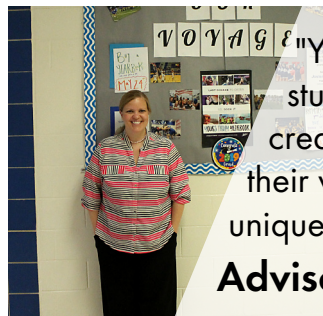
**COVER** The cover was designed by editors Elli Given and Payton Roth. We chose a map background to fit

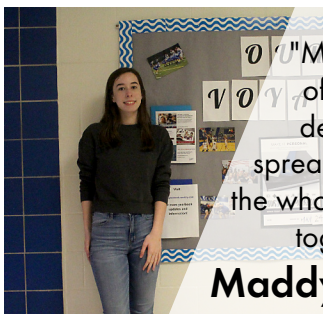

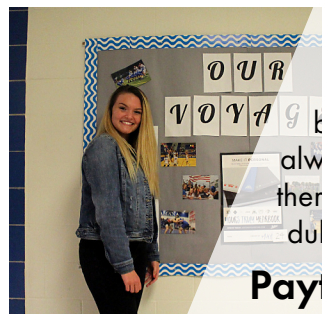

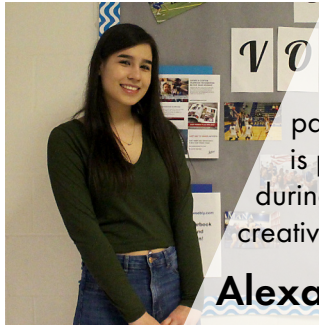
