Seven students enrolled in the advanced Yearbook Lab course created the 2019 *Trojan Epic* with the guidance of adviser Ginny Ordman. The 200-page yearbook was produced on 2.3 GHz Intel Core i5 computers, using Adobe InDesign CC 2018 and Photoshop CC 2018. Most sports photos were shot with Canon cameras. Process colors used included Culture *Cantaloupe*, *Dusty Rose*, *Shadow*, *Sienna*, *Skylark*, *Spirit*, and *Rainforest Cicada*. Most body copy was set in 10/12 Avalon Book; captions were set in 8/10 Avalon Book. The display fonts are Yours Truly Caps and Finn Print Light. The yearbook was printed on 80-pound gloss enamel paper, and four signatures (1, 2, 4 & 5) have a special UV coating to highlight the photographs. The super matte finish cover features a photo by Jack Dickens. Endsheets were printed on Snow White 280 stock with process colors on front and back. About 855 copies were printed in Clarksville, Tenn. The \$75 price included a 20-page spring supplement to be distributed in August.
