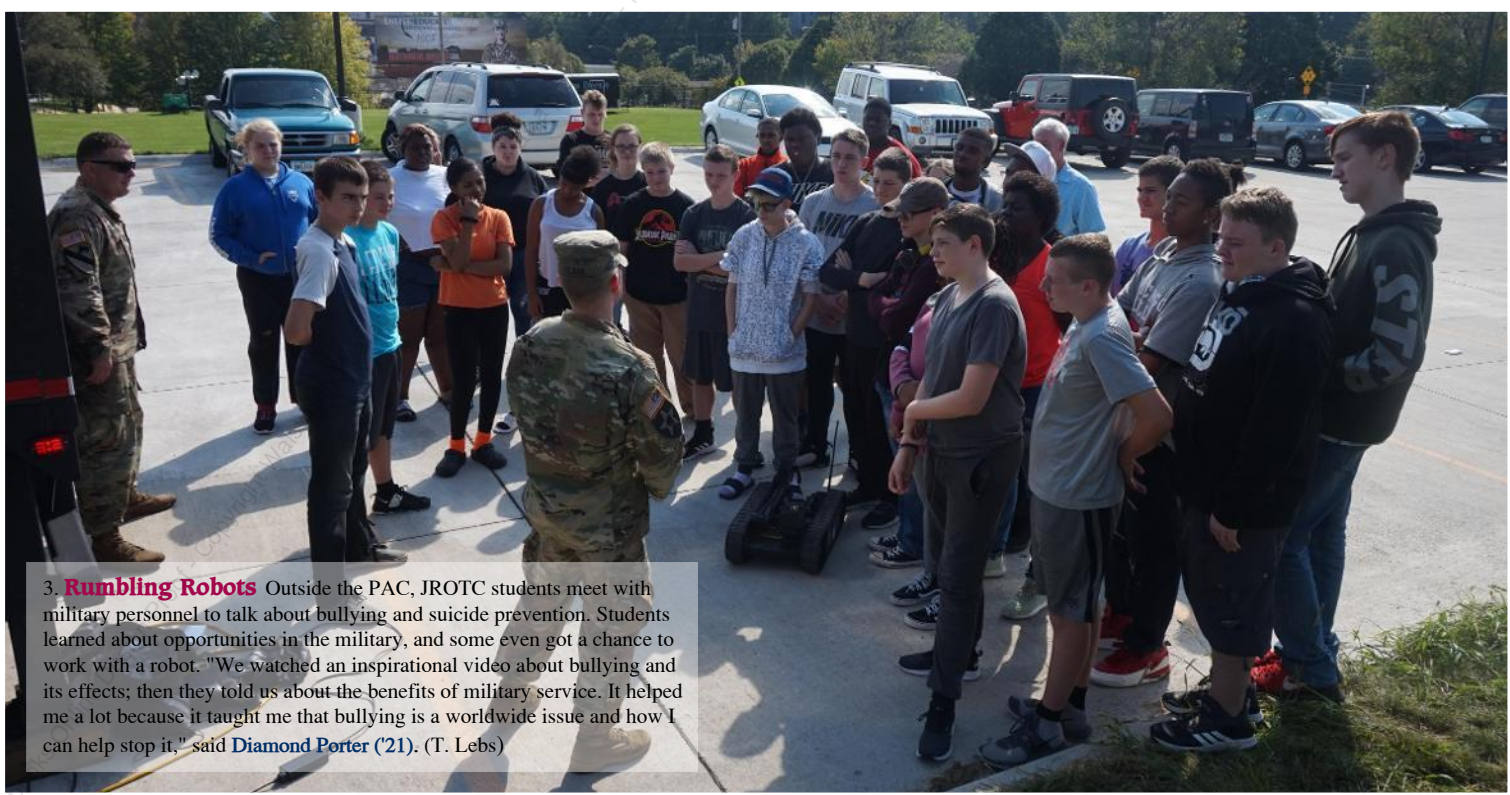
## These Devils Have Spring Fever
