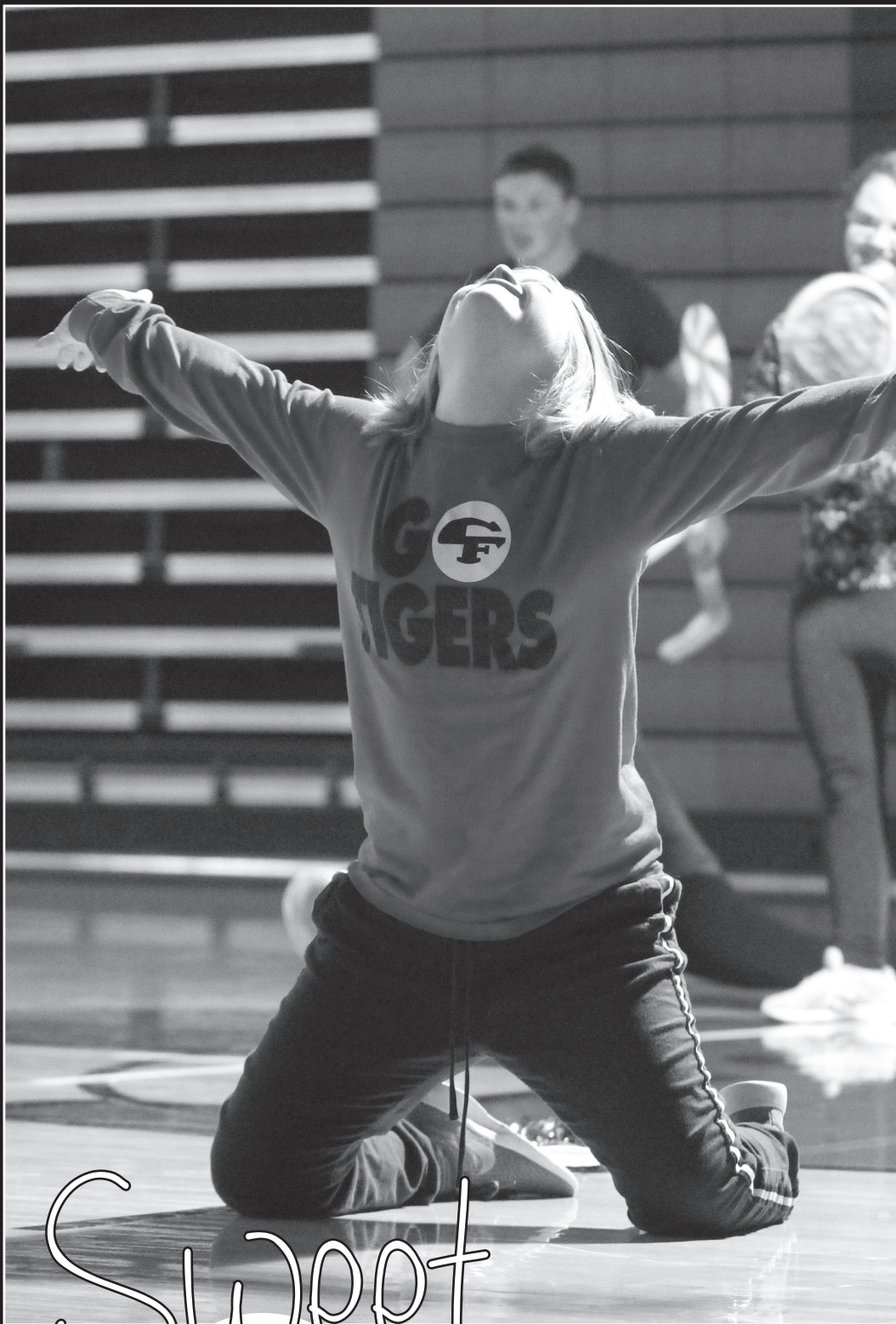
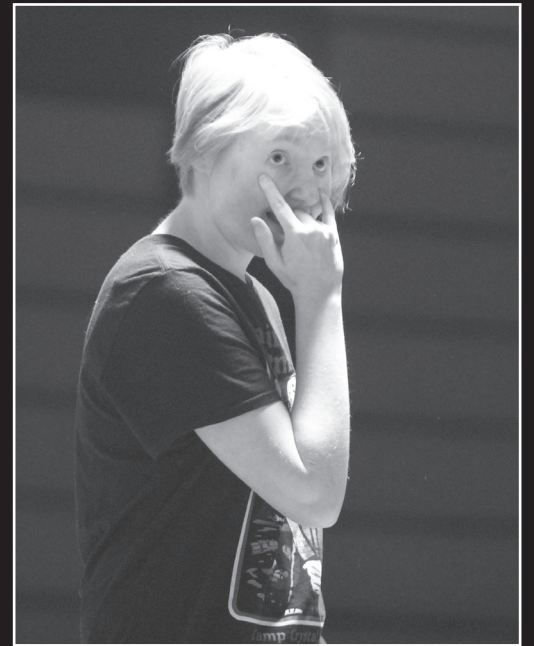

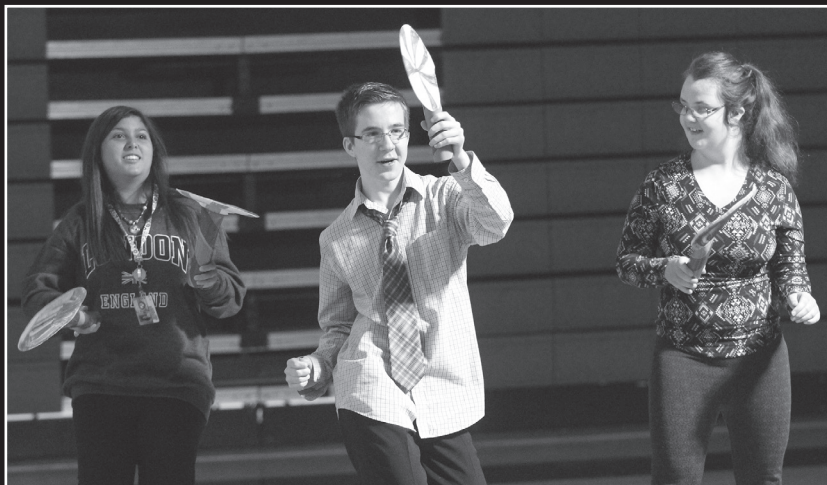

Bubble Rockets take title with 'I Want Candy'



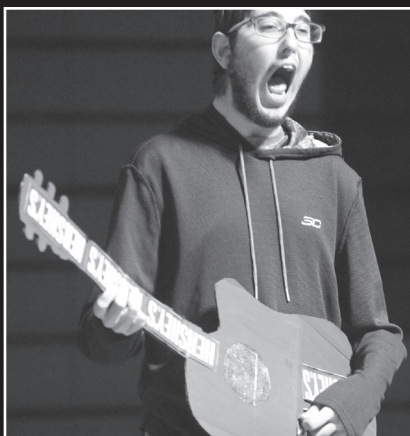
