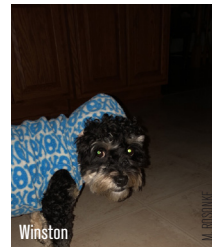

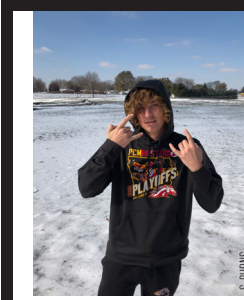


## Aloha!

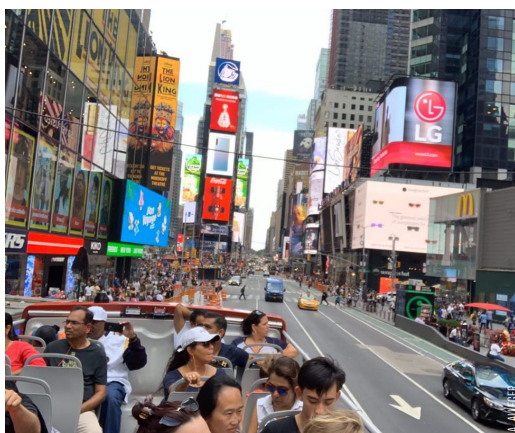


"Go out to the movies because I don't like to be in the house all of the time. I like to go out and do fun stuff." - Chloe Inskeep, 11

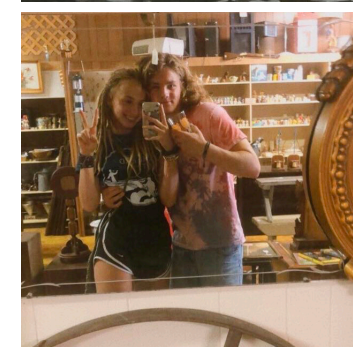
## Austin's Trip to New York

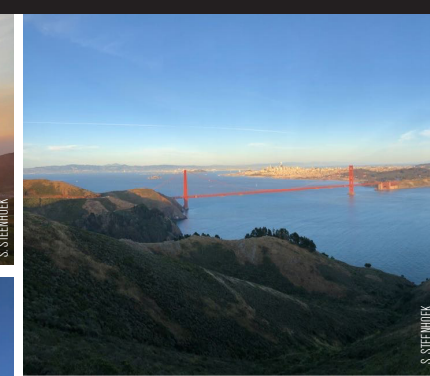
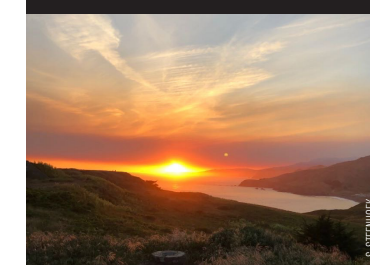


## Week on the Lake
