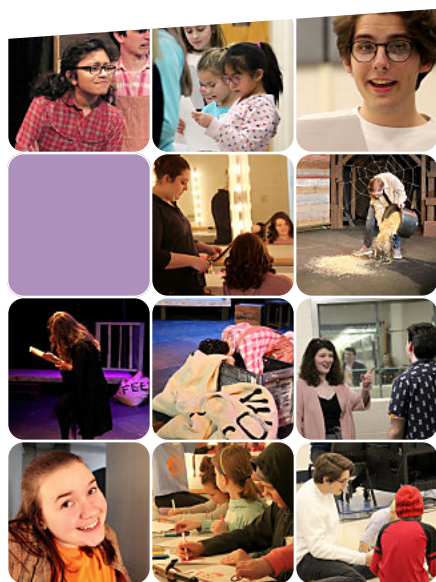
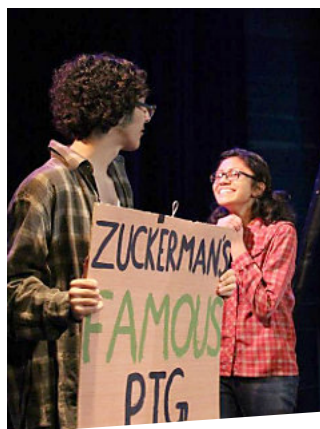

"I plan on continuing my education after high school and am interested in working in the education field through an admin position or through the classroom."



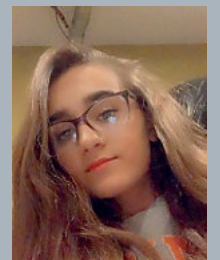
