"I was scared of the upperclassmen at first, but they leave you alone for the most part. I've opened up to making new friends with people in my classes."



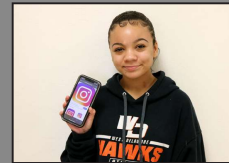
Erin Muller (9) ◀
