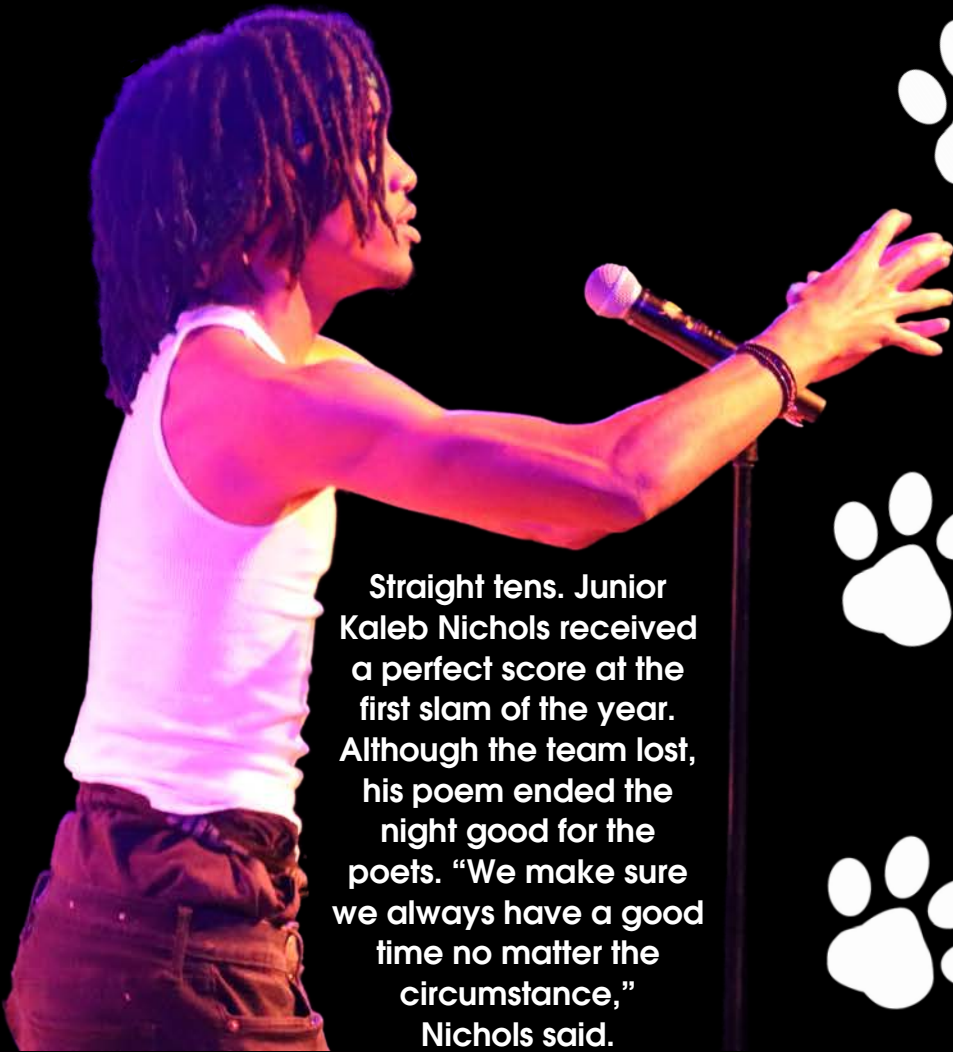


Oh snap, who's that, it's the Huskies
