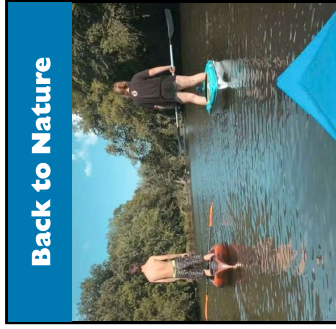
### Distributing Differently
