This 2020-2021 Valenian was the 61st edition. The theme this year was "Unprecedented," playing on the "UN," which is recurring in headlines and design elements throughout the book. On the right side of almost every spread, we placed a repeating book element, which reads "Unprecedented but Unified" and features four different Spartans, sharing a detail about how the pandemic affected their lives, but reminding us that we are all in this together.

The yearbook was created by/in the publications class, which meets 7th period each day in the PVHS news lab. The class is taught by Maureen Dyer, yearbook and newsmagazine adviser. The 2020-2021 yearbook editor-in-chief was senior Ella Litchfield. This was Ella's second year leading the publication and her first year as the sole editor. In addition to producing this book, students in publications are also responsible for producing the monthly Spartan Shield newsmagazine, led by editor-in-chief Alyce Brown. Our work in this class was honored when, in the fall of 2020, we were named an All lowa News Team of the Year in our class and our previous yearbook was named the Yearbook of the Year in our class.

The yearbook was printed by Jostens and designed using Jostens' Yearbook Avenue software program and Adobe Photoshop. We sold around 930 copies of the book at \$75 each.
