Falling into Autumn

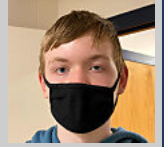

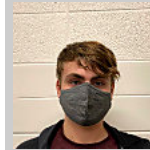
The spirit of these Spartans is **UN**breakable. Here's how they showed their resilience amidst the COVID-19 global pandemic.
