Aaron Dunkle (10) and Noah Jackson (11) work on the carburetor on Dunkle's dirt bike.

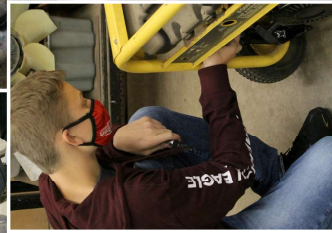
### Helping Hands

## Esports Gamers

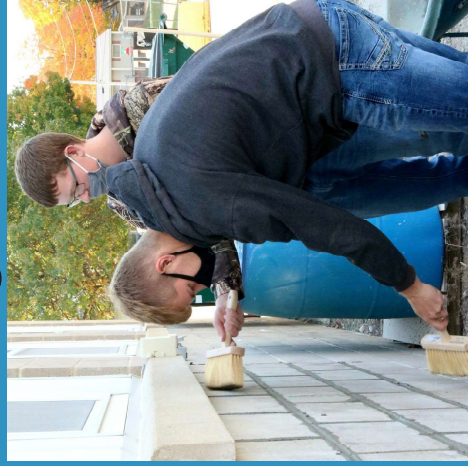
Practicing for junior varsity, Zachary Smith (9) prepares to play a scrimmage. "I was playing League of Legends," Smith said.
