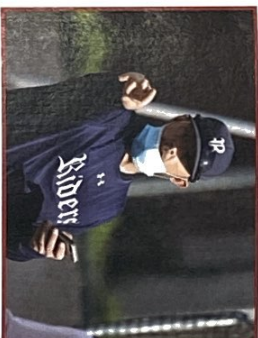


Roosevelt Welcomes
