

This is a higher maintenance method, as you must be sure you're using it correctly and replacing it on time. Then, there's external and internal condoms, which can be used along with other birth control methods or by themselves each time you have sex. Internal condoms are an alternative to regular condoms, and cover the inside of your vagina, creating a barrier just like a regular condom would. Condoms are 85% effective and cost \$0-2, while internal

Birth Control Can Prevent STIs- Even though barrier methods such as condoms can reduce risk of STIs, they do not prevent all STIs. For example, Herpes can live on parts of the genital that aren't covered by a condom.

Hormonal Types of Birth Control Can Cuase **Abortions-** Mainly made up by anti-abortion groups, birth controls cannot cuase abortions. Birth Control Damages Fertility- Although periods may be irregular after birth control this doesn't mean that this causes infertility. The Morning-after Pill Is Like an Abortion-Although high dosed birth controls such as Plan-B can be used to prevent pregnancy after unprotected sex, it does not cuase an abortion (an abortion is a medical procedure that interrupts the already established pregnancy.)

Older People Don't Need Birth Control-According to Zawn Villines, a medical and legal writer, it is still possible to get pregnant despite your age. "Until a person has gone through menopause and had 12 consecutive

months without a period, pregnancy is still possible. While male fertility also declines with age, males can remain fertile well into their 60s, 70s, and beyond." said Villines.

Because of these stereotypes, many women are left in the dark when knowing what to expect when starting birth control, and how important it is to customize your choice to your needs and lifestyle. "...I wish I would've known about how painful the IUD really is, and maybe more about what happens

after, like what to expect besides things like changes with your period ... " said Goode. It's important to know that you aren't married to one type of birth control once you start. For example, if you start off using the pill but you realize it isn't the right fit for you, talk to your doctor! You know your body best, so don't be afraid to switch methods if needed. Kali Anderson '23, isn't on birth control, but is disappointed with the lack of information she and others have received about birth control. "I think a big thing is the side effects. I barely even knew about birth control (particularly the pill) even after health class. Even with what they taught, I barely knew any of the side effects like depression, anxiety, just all the stuff that can come with taking birth control. If it weren't for the internet I wouldn't even know the side effects existed.' said Anderson. PPFA (Planned Parenthood Federation of America) is a non-profit healthcare orginization that

provides services such as birth control, cancer screening and prevention, hormone therapy, abortion, STD testing and more.
