Blackhawk Volume 99, "Part of the Story," was printed by Jostens Printing at 29625 84, Visalia, California, 93291. It was created at Central High School, 1120 Main Street, Davenport, Iowa, 52803. It was created using Jostens Yeartech Online Program and submitted through the online program. Our yearbook representative was Dan Patters. The all-color book contains 176 pages and 425 books were printed. The cost of the book was at \$80 at registration and then the book's cost rose to \$85. After that, the cost of the book rose to \$90 and will remain there when the books are delivered. The cover was designed by the editors using custom litho with high gloss finish, Spanish grain and Metallic Gold 873. The cover board weight was 150 pt. The front endsheets were designed by Natalie Lawton. The pages were printed on Snow White 290 stock and GL80 #191 weight paper. AYT Ebony was used for the body and captions. AYT Clearface Black was used for subheadlines and AYT Daisy was used for headlines. AYT Open Classic and AYT Clearface were used for miscellaneous text. Sidebar fonts were a mix of all four. Carlson Creative Images took senior portraits as well as various group, club and team photos. Lifetouch Photography took underclassmen and staff portraits. The color swatches used were CS Charcoal, VI Cloud, CL Blueberry, SP Mint, CL Spirit, ST Ginger, RF Pearl, NU Morning, ST Ghost Flower and CL Dusty Rose. Central is a member of NSPA and IHSPA.

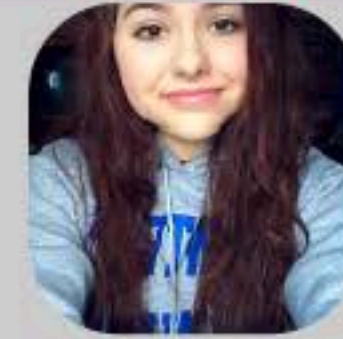

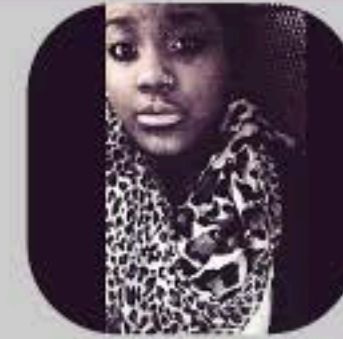
