"It was one of the best days of my life, to say the least. I've always liked them and the type of music they make. My favorite song would have to be *Fall Away*."

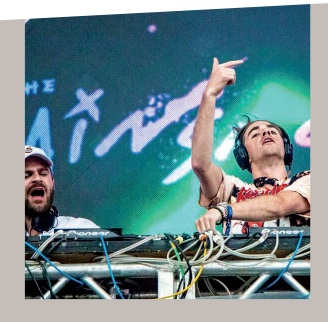

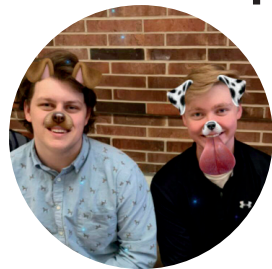

"I like this Snapchat filter because it makes me feel pretty and wanted," Eldridge said.



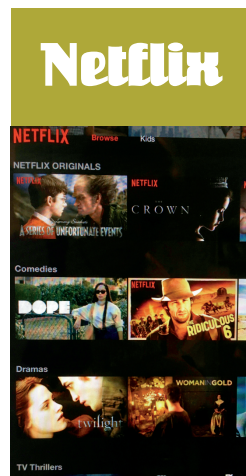
Dogs

The Geography of You and Me: "I've read a bunch of other books by this author and I really like her style, but this is one of my favorites," Allie Hambright '18 said.

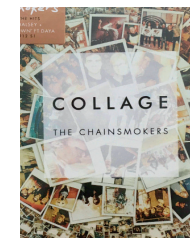

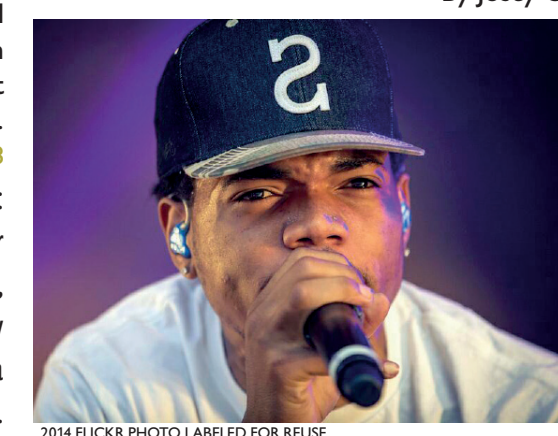
Kitra Bell '18 almost jumped out of her seat when the name Rhianna was brought up.
