PUERTO RICO

ADVANCING THE KEYSTONE XL AND DAKOTA ACCESS PIPELINE

These are two oil pipelines. Oil producers are expected to benefit from a quicker route for crude oil to US Gulf Coast refiners. However, Native American tribes are against the Dakota Access Pipeline stating it threatens water resources and sacred Native American sites. The Obama administration had previously rejected the Keystone XL project because of the environmental threats it posed.

TRAVEL BAN

Trump enacted a controversial, partial travel ban which barred people from seven Muslim-majority countries from entering the US temporarily for

TRUMP RESCINDS DACA

The Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals was an immigration policy implemented by the Obama administration that allowed some minors, who had entered or remained in the US illegally, to receive a renewable period of deferred action from deportation and eligibility for a work permit. In September, the Trump administration announced that it is ending the program.



TRANSGENDERS IN THE MILITARY
