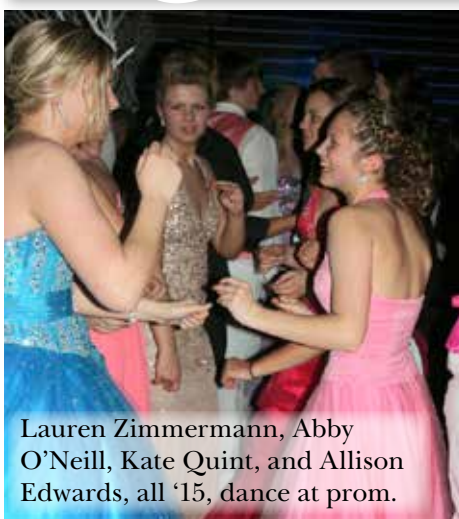


Prom: A Starry Night of many memories



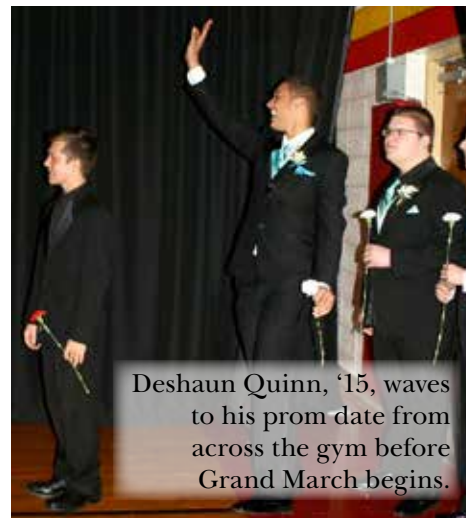
Lauren Zimmermann, Abby O'Neill, Kate Quint, and Allison Edwards, all '15, dance at prom.



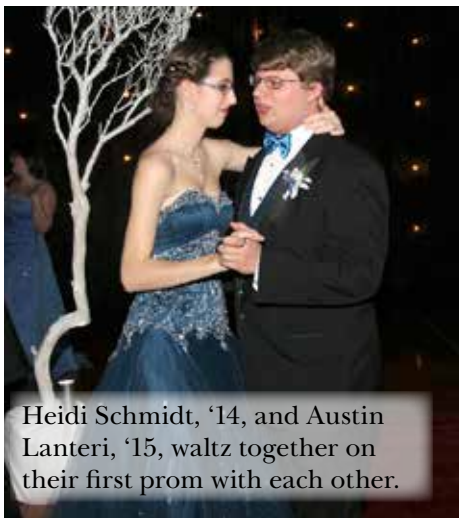
Michael Moeller, '14, poses for a selfie with his date at the end of the red carpet.
