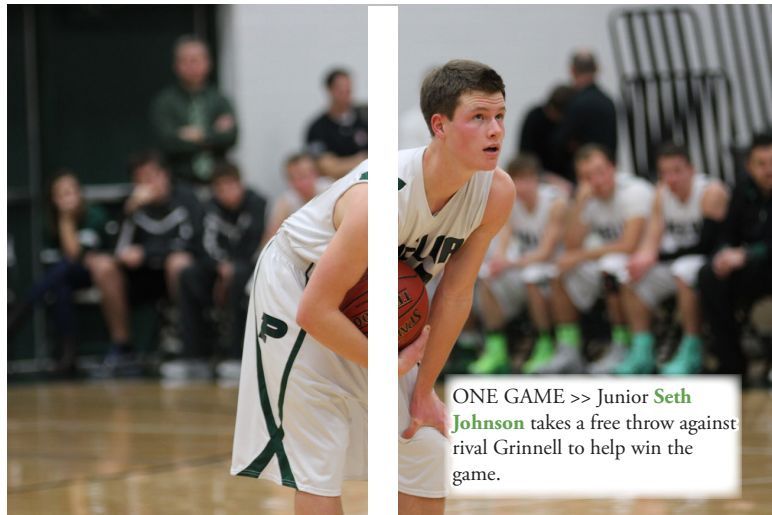
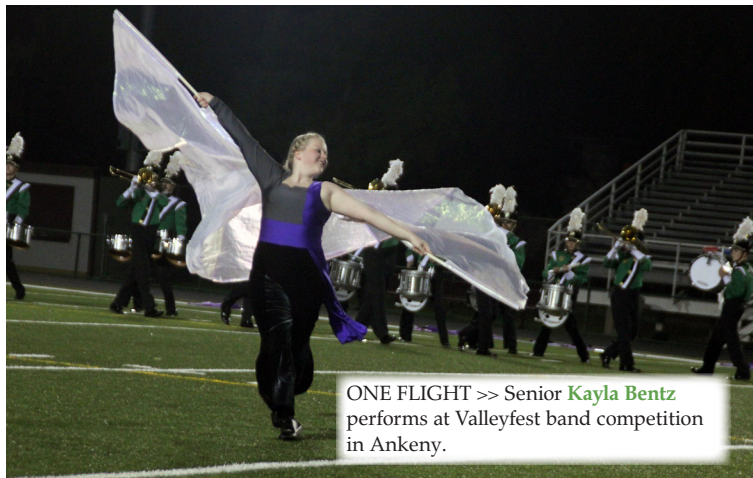

ONE GAME >> Junior **Seth Johnson** takes a free throw against rival Grinnell to help win the game.

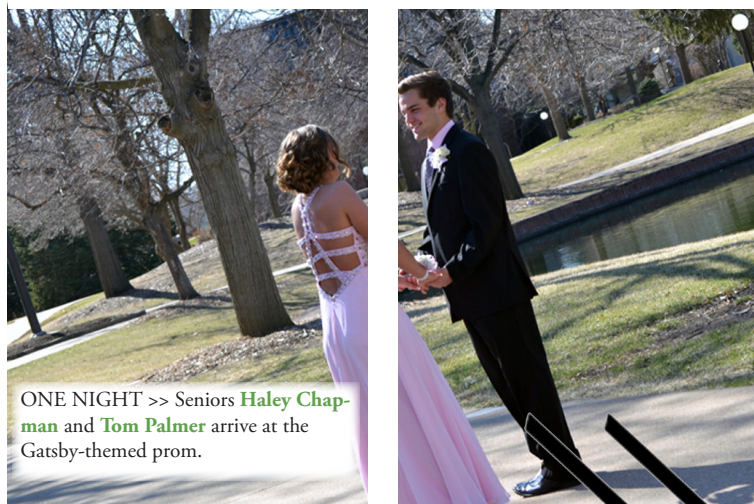


ONE FLIGHT >> Senior **Kayla Bentz** performs at Valleyfest band competition in Ankeny.
