"The project I did is a Hamsa hand, it symbolizes that everyone is equal," said Kyle Rustvold.

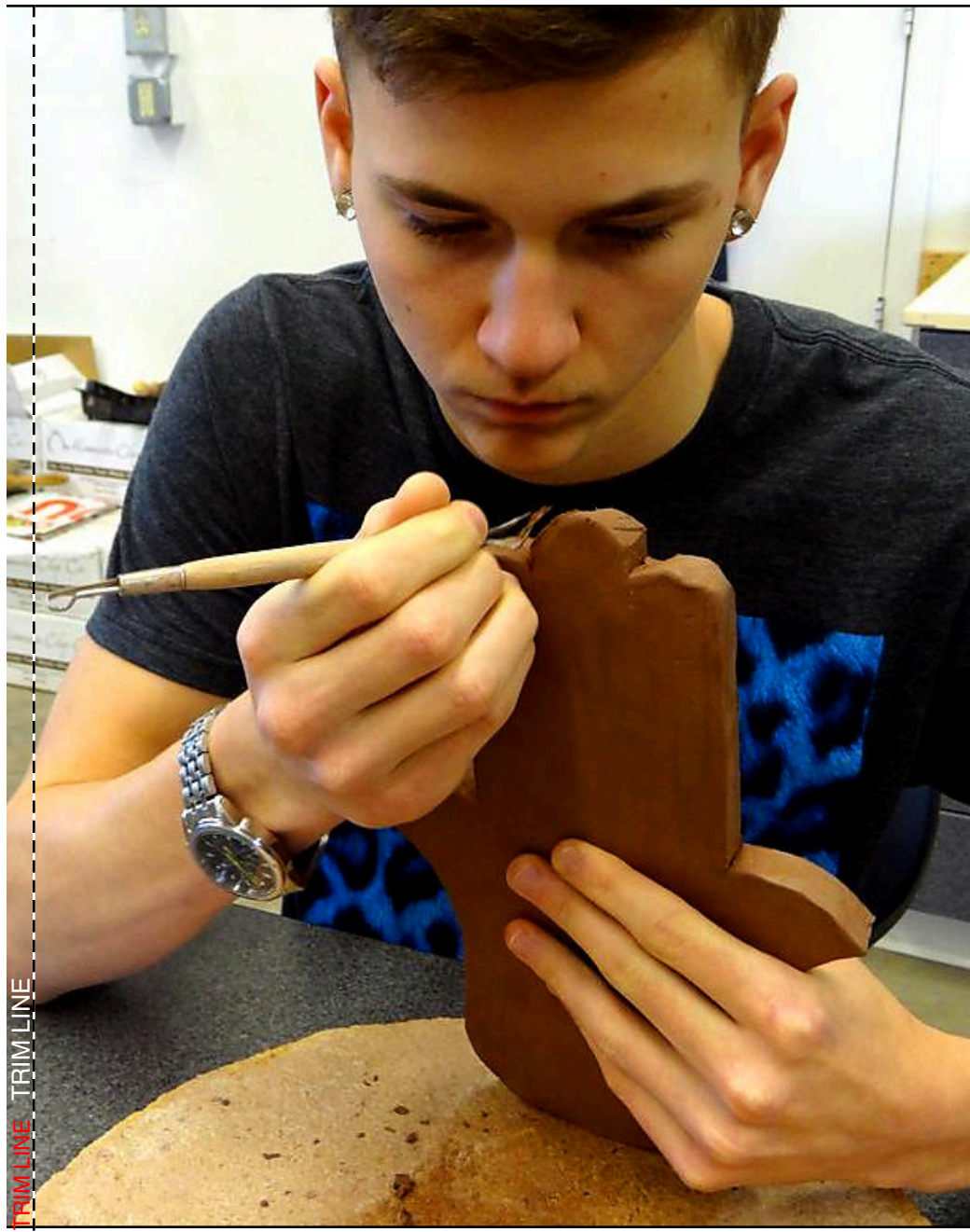

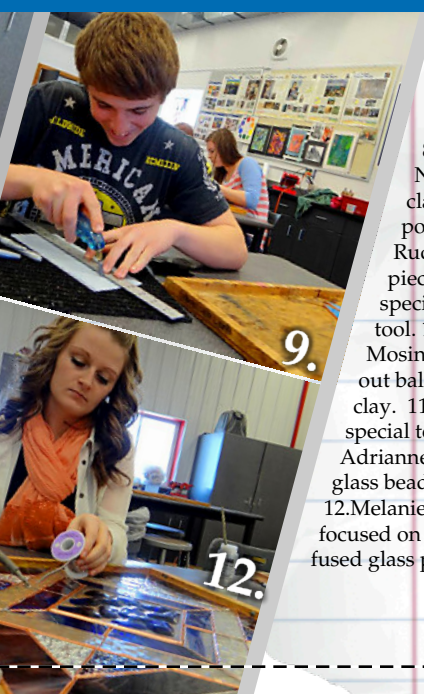
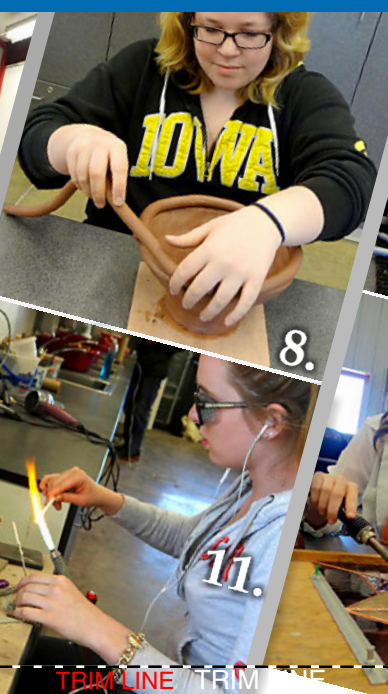
"I can't thank Mrs. Wallander enough for pushing me further, and always believing I could achieve what I set my mind to," said Carley Williamson, a senior in Art IV.
