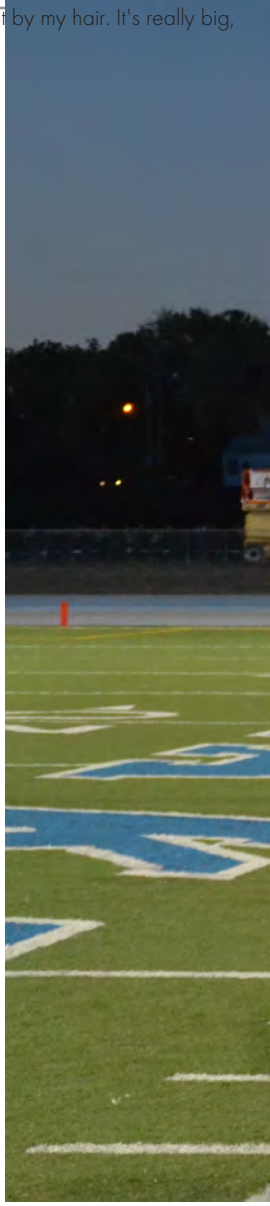
Cameron Cramer/9 is off to the races as he runs into the end-zone against North.

"First I want to help improve the team and make it into the playoffs heading into varsity football." Austin Hunter/10



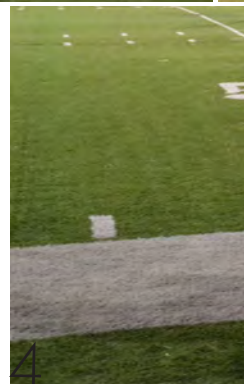
"My goal for next season is to get over 100 tackles." Liam Walling/9 said.
