From below ground level to the top of the main building, The Home of the Wildcats expanded its territory.


Above all the additions, the new Wildcat logo rose higher as it found its way onto helmets, shirts, planners, and the yearbook cover.


In progress, the anticipation of the new softball dugout and press box inspired athletic excitement.

Rising up to motivate the crowd, junior Melanie Curby lifts the sign as senior Brittney Teel hoists her above the crowd.








