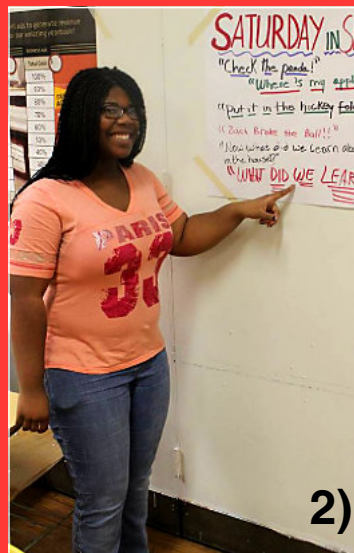

Playfully mischievous, our sophomore editor "Mickey" was able to take her own stylish ideas and incorporate them in pages.



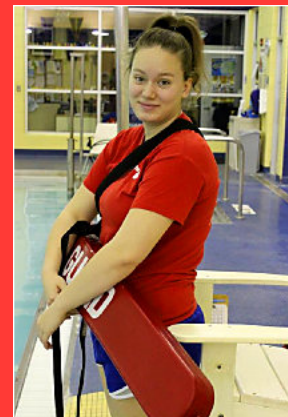
Jeremy Gares - Graphics & Senior Editor

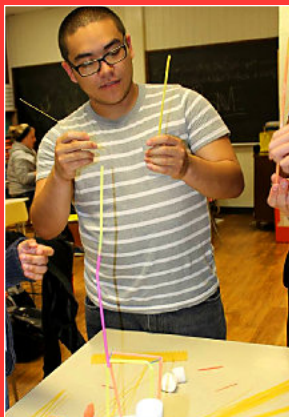


Betty Christian - Adviser
